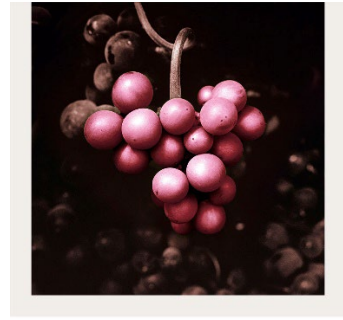

VINTAGE 2015

November was exceptionally dry and cool, but things started to warm up in December providing excellent conditions for flowering with an average-sized crop set. As the summer got into full swing Marlborough recorded the warmest Christmas Day in 66 years and second highest number of February sunshine hours since record-keeping began. Notably however, mean daily temperatures during mid-summer were below the long-term average, providing an idyllic sunny and dry growing environment without excessive heat.
